Hazardous Items

- Acids of any kind
- Aerosols
- Ammonia or cleaning solvents
- Ammunition
- Ammunition reloading components
- Butane
- Car batteries
- Charcoal
- Charcoal lighter fluid
- Chemicals i.e. darkroom or swimming pool chemicals
- Chemistry sets
- Fertilizer
- Fire Extinguisher
- Fireworks
- Gasoline
- Household batteries
- Kerosene
- Lamp oil
- Liquid bleach
- Loaded guns
- Matches
- Motor oil
- Nail polish
- Nail polish remover
- Paint thinner
- Paints (latex and oil based)
- Pesticides
- Poisons i.e. weed killer
- Propane tanks
- Sterno
- Wine and Liquor

Perishable Items

- Frozen or refrigerated food
- Live plants
- Open or half-used food or drink
- Produce
